We look at concerns reported to us about firms or individuals we regulate and decide whether to investigate them.

How we get reports

Reports come to us from many sources:

- firms making reports about themselves or individuals who are or have been employed by them
- · employees reporting the firm they work for
- · firms or solicitors making reports about others in the profession
- · clients of firms
- · the police and the courts
- the Legal Ombudsman
- · other regulators and MPs

We do not investigate every report we receive.
