General information

A full-time Legal Practice Course (LPC) has been offered at Anglia Ruskin since 1994 and a part-time LPC since 2001. Both courses form part of a comprehensive range of undergraduate and postgraduate courses offered by Anglia Law School. The law school has a considerable reputation in the area of legal skills, and students successfully completing the LPC have good employment prospects. Both courses are small, friendly and practical, being primarily orientated to regional practice. The LPC at Anglia Ruskin was graded as 'good' during the last full assessment visit. Successful students can go on to take an LL.M in Legal Practice by completing a 25,000-word dissertation, which may cover any topic related to legal practice, subject to the law school's approval.
