General information

The Law Department, founded in 1901, is situated on the main campus overlooking the lively student town of Aberystwyth, located on the dramatic west coast of Wales. The department has a long, reputable and varied experience of legal education and academic work in undergraduate, postgraduate and professional development programmes. The campus has a warm and welcoming community atmosphere and boasts some of the best academic support in the country. Recently, the National Student Satisfaction Survey named Aberystwyth as joint third in the UK and the leader in Wales for overall student satisfaction.

The Legal Practice Course is hosted within the Law Department's Centre for Legal Practice. Classes are small, focusing on providing students with practical experience in a friendly, supportive environment. Strong links with the professional community are maintained through guest lectures and tutoring. The LPC benefits from a newly refurbished suite of rooms including a dedicated Resource Centre with generous IT facilities, study materials and a lounge area. Students also have access to our mature and well stocked Law Library, departmental IT facilities and the National Library of Wales close by.
