Consequential Amendments to the SRA Standards and Regulations

As well as those rules and regulations explicitly dealt with in the consultation, we will be required to make other consequential changes to our wider Standards and Regulations, including the SRA Glossary.

We have not reproduced all of these documents for the purposes of this consultation but instead set out below the changes we have identified.

SRA Regulatory Arrangement	Proposed Amendment
SRA Overseas Rules	We will amend to add reference to <i>authorised CILEX lawyers</i> , specifically at rules 1.3 and 5.1(a)
Roll, Registers and Publication Regulations	 We will amend the following regulations: Regulation 1 – add "a <i>register</i> of all <i>authorised CILEX lawyers</i>" and "a <i>register</i> of <i>SRA-ACCA Probate entities</i>" Regulation 2 – add "in respect of <i>authorised CILEX lawyers</i>, the date of their authorization and <i>Reserved Legal Activity</i> (plus immigration) they hold" and at 2.1(e) and (f) include "and <i>authorised CILEX lawyers</i>" after "in respect of <i>solicitors</i>". Regulation 3 – add "in respect of <i>authorised CILEX bodies</i> and <i>SRA-ACCA Probate entities</i> the <i>Reserved Legal Activity</i> for which they are authorised" Regulation 4 – add at 4.2(a) after (including former solicitors RELs and RFLs) "and <i>authorised CILEX lawyers</i>".
Transparency Rules	We will amend to add reference to <i>authorised CILEX lawyers</i> , specifically at rules 4.3 and 4.4
Indemnity Insurance Rules	We will make appropriate amendments to ensure these encompass <i>authorised CILEX bodies</i>

associate prosecutor	a person authorised by the SRA pursuant to the Associate Prosecutor Rights of Audience and Litigation Certification Rules
authorised CILEX lawyer	a person authorised by the <i>SRA</i> pursuant to the SRA Authorisation of CILEX Lawyers Regulations
authorised CILEX body	a body authorised by the SRA pursuant to Rules 1.1(d) of the SRA Authorisation of Firm Rules
CILEX member	A person who is registered with the Chartered Institute of Legal Executives in accordance with the Royal Charter and Bye-Laws of the Chartered Institute of Legal Executives
CILEX qualifying experience	at least 2300 hours of work that contributes to the provision of legal services, which may include a period of up to 644 hours spent in attendance on a <i>Legal Practice Course</i> recognised by the Law Society of England and Wales in connection with qualification as a solicitor or the Bar Training Course recognised by the Bar Council in connection with qualification as a barrister
fellow	a person admitted as a fellow pursuant to Regulation 2 of the SRA Authorisation of CILEX Lawyers Regulations or a person admitted as a Fellow of Chartered Institute of Legal Executives
practising overseas	 amend sub-paragraph (c) to state: (c) of a solicitor or authorised CILEX lawyer established outside England and Wales for the purpose of providing legal services in an overseas jurisdiction; and
practising rights certificate	a certificate awarded pursuant to Regulation 3 of the SRA Authorisation of CILEX Lawyers Regulations
private legal practice	In paragraph (i) add "or <i>authorised CILEX lawyer</i> " after <i>"solicitor</i> or <i>REL</i> "
register	After "the LSA" add:(e) the register of authorised CILEX lawyers(f) the register of SRA-ACCA Probate entities
regulated individual	After "overseas practice" add: (d) an authorised CILEX lawyer
