# SRA Roll, Registers and Publication Regulations

### Introduction

These regulations set out the nature and contents of the registers and the roll that the SRA is required to keep. They contain certain information about the individuals and firms that the SRA regulates and how we make this information available to the public.

This introduction does not form part of the SRA Roll, Registers and Publication Regulations.

## SRA Roll, Registers and Publication Regulations

#### Regulation 1: The roll and registers

- **1.1** The SRA [https://www.sra.org.uk/solicitors/standards-regulations/glossary/#SRA] shall keep in electronic form:
  - (a) the roll;
  - (b) a register of all solicitors [https://www.sra.org.uk/solicitors/stanc regulations/glossary/#solicitor] who hold practising certificates
  - (c) the register of European lawyers [https://www.sra.org.uk/solicitors/standards-regulations/glossary/#reg of-European-lawyers];
  - (d) the register of foreign lawyers [https://www.sra.org.uk/solicitors/standards-regulations/glossary/#reg of-foreign-lawyers]; and
  - (e) a register of authorised bodies
    [https://www.sra.org.uk/solicitors/standardsregulations/glossary/#authorised-body] .

### Regulation 2: Information in respect of individuals

- 2.1 The roll, and the registers in regulation 1.1(b) to (d) shall contain the following information in respect of each individual included in the same:
  - (a) their full name;
  - (b) their authorisation number;

- (c) the date of their admission as a solicitor [https://www.sra.org.uk/solicitors/standards-regulations/glossary/#soli or commencement of their registration, as appropriate;
- (d) in respect of solicitors [https://www.sra.org.uk/solicitors/standard regulations/glossary/#solicitor] that hold a current practising certificate, the fact that they do so and the commencem date of the certificate;
- in respect of solicitors [https://www.sra.org.uk/solicitors/standard regulations/glossary/#solicitor] whose practising certificate has expired, the expiry date;
- (f) their main practising address;
- the name of all organisations through which they practis and whether the organisation is authorised by the SRA [https://www.sra.org.uk/solicitors/standards-regulations/glossary/#SR. by another approved regulator [https://www.sra.org.uk/solicitors/standards-regulations/glossary/#appregulator], or is not authorised under the LSA [https://www.sra.org.uk/solicitors/standards-regulations/glossary/#LS/they are not practising through an organisation, the fact this is the case, and subject to regulation 2.2, whether the are practising in accordance with regulation 10.2(a) of the SRA Authorisation of Individuals Regulations or in the circumstances set out in 10.2(b)(i) to (vii) of the same;
- (h) if they are not practising, an address for correspondence
- (i) details of:
  - (i) any conditions on their practising certificate o which they are subject;
  - (ii) any current suspension of their practising cer registration;
  - (iii) any other decision subject to publication under the SRA Regulatory and Disciplinary Procedu
  - (iv) any other order made by the Tribunal [https://www.sra.org.uk/solicitors/standards-regulations/g and
  - (v) the exercise by the SRA [https://www.sra.org.uk/sc regulations/glossary/#SRA] of any powers of interv [https://www.sra.org.uk/solicitors/standardsregulations/glossary/#intervention] in relation to their

Where a solicitor [https://www.sra.org.uk/solicitors/standards-regulations/glossary/#solicitor] or an REL [https://www.sra.org.uk/solicitors/standards-regulations/glossary/#REL] practises in accordance with regulation 10.2(a) of the SRA Authorisation of Individuals Regulations or in the circumstances set out in regulation 10.2(b)(i) to (vii) of the same, the fact that they practise in this way does not need to be included in the roll or the registers under regulation 2.1(g) if all legal services, when practising in this way, are provided pro bono.

### Regulation 3: Information in respect of authorised bodies

- 3.1 The register of authorised bodies
  [https://www.sra.org.uk/solicitors/standardsregulations/glossary/#authorised-body] under regulation 1.1(e) shall
  contain the following information in respect of each body
  included within it:
  - (a) the name under which the body is authorised;
  - (b) the body's authorisation number;
  - (c) the body's main practising address in the UK [https://www.sra.org.uk/solicitors/standards-regulations/glossary/#UK]
  - (d) all the body's other practising addresses including addresses of its overseas practices [https://www.sra.org.uk/solicitors/standards-regulations/glossary/#ove practice];
  - (e) any previous name under which the body has been authorised by the SRA [https://www.sra.org.uk/solicitors/standar regulations/glossary/#SRA];
  - (f) any other trading styles used by the body;
  - (g) the date from which the body's authorisation has effect;
  - (h) the prescribed [https://www.sra.org.uk/solicitors/standardsregulations/glossary/#prescribed] categories of work that the b provides;
  - the reserved legal activities
     [https://www.sra.org.uk/solicitors/standards-regulations/glossary/#reslegal-activities] that the body is authorised to carry on;
  - (j) whether the body is a recognised body [https://www.sra.org.uk/solicitors/standardsregulations/glossary/#recognised-body], a recognised sole practice.

- (k) details of:
  - (i) any current condition to which the body's auth subject;
  - (ii) any suspension or revocation of the body's at

  - (iv) any other order made by the Tribunal [https://www.sra.org.uk/solicitors/standards-regulations/g and

- 3.2 For each licensed body [https://www.sra.org.uk/solicitors/standards-regulations/glossary/#licensed-body] the register of authorised bodies [https://www.sra.org.uk/solicitors/standards-regulations/glossary/#authorised-body] must contain:
  - (a) the name of the individual who is designated as the boo HOLP [https://www.sra.org.uk/solicitors/standardsregulations/glossary/#HOLP], together with details of the approved regulator [https://www.sra.org.uk/solicitors/standardsregulations/glossary/#approved-regulator] with whom that perso authorised;
  - (b) the name of the individual who is designated as the boo HOFA [https://www.sra.org.uk/solicitors/standardsregulations/glossary/#HOFA]; and
  - the body's registered office and registered number if it is LLP [https://www.sra.org.uk/solicitors/standards-regulations/glossary/#LLP] or company [https://www.sra.org.uk/solicitors/standards-regulations/glossary/#con and if it is a charity [https://www.sra.org.uk/solicitors/standards-regulations/glossary/#charity], its charity [https://www.sra.org.uk/solicitors/standards-regulations/glossary/#charity] https://www.sra.org.uk/solicitors/standards-regulations/glossary/#charity].

### Regulation 4: General provisions

- 4.1 The SRA [https://www.sra.org.uk/solicitors/standards-regulations/glossary/#SRA] may include in the roll or registers such other prescribed [https://www.sra.org.uk/solicitors/standards-regulations/glossary/#prescribed] information it considers conducive to help it meet the regulatory objectives [https://www.sra.org.uk/solicitors/standards-regulations/glossary/#regulatory-objectives].
- **4.2** The SRA [https://www.sra.org.uk/solicitors/standards-regulations/glossary/#SRA] shall keep and publish lists of:
  - (a) orders made by the Tribunal

- 5.1 The SRA [https://www.sra.org.uk/solicitors/standards-regulations/glossary/#SRA] shall publish all entries on the roll or registers, except for any address included under regulation 2.1(h).
- 5.2 If the SRA [https://www.sra.org.uk/solicitors/standards-regulations/glossary/#SRA] considers that it would be in the public interest to do so, it may withhold from publication any or all of the information subject to publication under regulation 5.1.
- 5.3 The SRA [https://www.sra.org.uk/solicitors/standards-regulations/glossary/#SRA] may publish such further information or classes of information as it may consider in the public interest to do so.
