Decision details

1. You are not a manager or owner of any authorised body or authorised non-SRA firm.
2. Subject to condition 1, you may act as a solicitor, only as an employee, where the role has first been approved by us.
3. You may not act as a compliance officer for legal practice (COLP) or compliance officer for finance and administration (COFA) for any authorised body, or Head of Legal Practice (HOLP) or head of finance and administration (HOFA) in any authorised non-SRA firm.

In these conditions the terms are as defined in the SRA Glossary.

Reasons/basis

The above conditions are necessary in the public interest and reasonable and proportionate having regard to the purposes set out in regulation 7 of the SRA Authorisation of Individuals Regulations, and the regulatory

objectives and principles governing regulatory activities as contained in section 28 of the Legal Services Act 2007.

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
