Warning: Website claiming to be for a law firm called 'Roy Arthur Morgan Solicitor'

The website 'www.royarthurmorgan.com' is operating, claiming to offer legal services through 'Roy Arthur Morgan Solicitor'.

What is the scam?

The website 'www.royarthurmorgan.com' is operating, claiming to offer legal services.

The website seen by the SRA misuses the name and SRA ID of a genuine solicitor (see below). The website provides a contact email address of 'info@royarthurmorgan.com' and a postal address of '2 Dearmans PI, Salford M3 5DS'.

Any business or transaction through the website, 'www.royarthurmorgan.com', the email address 'info@royarthurmorgan.com' or the postal address '2 Dearmans PI, Salford M3 5DS' is not undertaken by a firm or individual authorised and regulated by the SRA.

Is there a genuine firm or person?

The SRA authorises and regulates a solicitor called Roy Arthur Morgan, with SRA ID: 124035.

Roy Arthur Morgan has confirmed that he has no connection to the website referred to above.

What should I do?

When a firm's or individual's identity has been copied exactly (or cloned), due diligence is necessary. If you receive correspondence claiming to be from the above firm(s) or individual(s), or information of a similar nature to that described, you should conduct your own due diligence by checking the authenticity of the correspondence by contacting the law firm directly by reliable and established means. You can contact the SRA to find out if individuals or firms are regulated and authorised by the SRA and verify an individual's or firm's practising details. Other verification methods, such as checking public records (e.g. telephone directories and company records) may be required in other circumstances.
