- 1. Mr Mawbey-Shaw may not practise as a sole practitioner or sole manager or sole owner of an authorised or recognised body.
- 2. Mr Mawbey-Shaw may not be a compliance officer for legal practice (COLP) or a compliance officer for finance and administration (COFA).
- 3. Mr Mawbey-Shaw must not practise on his own account under regulation 10.2(a) or (b) of the SRA Authorisation of Individuals Regulations.

In these conditions the terms are as defined in the SRA Glossary.

#### Reasons/basis

The above conditions are necessary in the public interest. They are reasonable and proportionate having regard to the purposes set out in regulation 7 of the SRA Authorisation of Individuals Regulations, and the



regulatory objectives and principles governing regulatory activities as contained in section 28 of the Legal Services Act 2007.
