- 1. Mr Chatrath is not a manager or owner of any authorised body or authorised non-SRA firm.
- 2. Subject to the condition above, Mr Chatrath may act as a solicitor, only as an employee, where the role has first been approved by us.
- 3. Mr Chatrath may not act as a compliance officer for legal practice (COLP) or compliance officer for finance and administration (COFA) for an authorised body, or Head of Legal Practice (HOLP) or head of finance and administration (HOFA) in any authorised non-SRA firm.
- 4. Mr Chatrath does not hold or receive client money, or act as a signatory to any client or office account or have the power to authorise transfers from any client or office account.

In these conditions the definitions are as defined in the SRA Glossary.

The above conditions are necessary in the public interest and reasonable and proportionate having regard to the purposes set out in Regulation 7 of the SRA Authorisation of Individuals Regulations and the regulatory objectives and principles governing regulatory activities as contained in section 28 of the Legal Services Act 2007.
