- Mr Davis may not practise on his own account under regulation 10.2(a) or (b) of the SRA Authorisation of Individuals Regulations.

Outcome of SDT Hearing

This notification relates to a Decision to prosecute before the Solicitors Disciplinary Tribunal. This is an independent Tribunal which reaches its own decision after considering all the evidence, including any evidence put forward by the Respondent. The Tribunal had certified that there was a case to answer.

The matter was heard on 5 and 6 October 2021.

Mr. Davis was fined £30,000.

He shall also be subject to conditions imposed by the Tribunal as follows:

He may not:

 be a Compliance Officer for Legal Practice, Compliance Officer for Finance and Administration, Money Laundering



Compliance Officer or Money Laundering Reporting Officer.

- 2. act as a manager or owner for any authorised body other than Davis-Law Associates (SRA ID: 522432).
- provide legal services as a freelance solicitor offering reserved or unreserved services under Regulations 10.2(a) or (b) of the SRA Authorisation of Individuals Regulations.
