- 3. Mr Peacock may not act as a compliance officer for legal practice (COLP) or compliance officer for finance and administration (COFA) for any authorised body.
- 4. Mr Peacock does not hold or receive client money, or act as a signatory to any client or office account or have the power to authorise transfers from any client or office account.
