## Outcome details

This outcome was reached by SRA decision.

Decision details

Baron Grey Limited is a recognised body whose office is at 441 Richmond Road, Twickenham, TW1 2EF.

It was found that:

Baron Grey Limited failed to have in place, contrary to Regulation 18(4) of Money Laundering, Terrorist Financing and Transfer of Funds (Information on the Payer) Regulations 2017 (MLRs 2017), a documented and compliant firm-wide risk assessment between 26 June 2017 and 9 November 2021.

In doing so the firm:

- i. breached Principles 6 and 8 of the SRA Principles 2011, and
- ii. failed to achieve Outcome 7.5 of the SRA Code of Conduct 2011 and where the conduct occurred after 25 November

- iii. breached Principle 2 of the SRA Principles, and
- iv. breached Paragraph 2.1(a) of the SRA Code of Conduct for Firms

The firm was directed to pay a penalty of £1,200 and ordered to pay costs of £600. SRA Principles 2011Principle 6 You must behave in a way that maintains the trust the public places in you and in the provision of legal services

Principle 8 You must run your business or carry out your role in the business effectively and in accordance with proper governance and sound financial and risk management principles

Outcome 7.5 You comply with legislation applicable to your business, including anti-money laundering and data protection legislation
